At any incident, the Safety officer will report to the Officer in Charge (OIC), and then they will establish an accountability system and report any immediate safety concerns. If the designated Safety Officer is not on scene, one maybe appointed to position, by the Incident Commander. The Safety Officer does have the ability to move freely around the scene. The Safety Officer may seek or have assistance from other personnel on the scene or other Safety Officers from other departments for Safety duties.

It is also the responsibility of the Safety Officer to establish and monitor a Rehab sector. The Safety Officer does have the power to remove any firefighter from any duties if their health and or safety are in danger.
